


Getting to Charing Cross Hospital

By tube

Hammersmith station (Hammersmith & City, Piccadilly and District lines) – 10 minute walk Barons Court station (Piccadilly and District lines) – 10 minute walk

By bus

The following buses stop outside the hospital: 190, 211, 220, 295

Parking

Parking is very limited at and around the hospital and charges apply. Please bring plenty of change for the machines or meters. Parking is free for registered disabled and valid badge holders.

Patient transport

You may be able to book onto the hospital's patient transport service if your medical or mobility condition means that you cannot travel to or from your appointment using any other method of transport. Please call the telephone number above for more information.

How to find the breast screening clinic

Enter the hospital through the main entrance on Fulham Palace Road and take the escalator or lift to the first floor. At the top of the escalator, bear left and walk straight ahead or come out of the lift and walk past the café. Go past the Main Outpatients check-in and turn right, through a set of open doors, into the West Wing. Walk down the corridor, past the Breast Services clinic on the left, and take the first turning on the left. Follow the corridor around the corner and take the first turning on the left, through a set of doors. Turn right and the breast screening reception/clinic is at the end of the corridor on the left-hand side.
