COVID Spring Booster: 2025

The <u>National Booking System</u> opens on 25 March to book appointments from 1 April.

If you or someone you know can't get online, book by calling 119 free of charge, where a translator is available if needed.

You can get a COVID-19 vaccine if you:

- are aged 75 or over (including those who will be 75 by 17 June 2025)
- are aged 6 months to 74 years and have a weakened immune system due to a health condition or treatment
- live in a care home for older adults

Protect your teen: book in for their DTP and Meningitis ACWY vaccinations (13-18 vears old)

- Diphtheria Throat/nose infection which can lead to breathing difficulties and heart failure and, if left untreated, death
- Tetanus Bacterial infection that can lead to muscle spasms, lockjaw and death
- Polio Virus that can lead to paralysis
- Meningitis Inflammation of the brain/spinal cord which can lead to the loss of limbs/death

These vaccines are routinely offered in Year 9 to complete the immunisation schedule, but if they missed them, they are still eligible up to 18 years old. Please scan this QR code to book into a clinic:


